Dear Saint Joe Family and Friends,

By now, we have become accustomed to the pervasiveness of COVID-19 and the myriad protocols put in place, such as masking and physical distancing. We have learned new vocabulary and new ways of interacting with one another as a result of the pandemic. What was once mysterious and uncertain has become wearying yet familiar.

In the summer of 2020, the COVID mitigation team of Saint Joseph High School -- a group comprised of administrators, faculty/staff, students, and school board members -- worked hard to formulate a plan for Back to School, one that reflected love, care, and the unrelenting desire to do what is best for all members of the Saint Joe family.

Consistent with our core values, and reflecting the 2021-22 theme Build Family, the plan kept students at the center of our mission. The COVID mitigation team developed strategies to address potential learning loss, identified ways to continue the academic excellence for which Saint Joe is known, and outlined three modes of learning that enabled faculty to provide continuity as we adapted to changing circumstances. Additionally, and of equal importance, the team identified ways to cultivate student faith formation and to support their social emotional wellbeing, whether students were learning in person or remotely. Staying true to our mission to transform students in heart and mind, it remained critical to foster student development and build the Saint Joe family throughout every possible scenario.

When the 2020-21 school year began, we did not anticipate that the safety protocols, mitigation measures — or even COVID-19 itself — would last the entire year. As the pandemic prevailed, so did our community. Despite the constant need to adapt, modify, and pivot, we were able to deliver on our promise of an unparalleled Catholic high school education.

In looking back over the past year, it is evident that the Saint Joe experience continued, and that our efforts bore fruit. For example, 98% of the Class of 2021 were admitted to four-year institutions, receiving a combined \$14.5 million in college scholarships. Additionally, as you will read later in this report, nine students were confirmed in the Catholic faith. Other notable highlights include:

- 5 National Merit Commended Scholars, 1 National Merit Winner, 3 National Merit Finalists
- 14 Scholastic Art Award Winners
- Over 16,000 service hours performed
- 23 members of the Class of 2021 signed as NCAA athletes
- 2 individual State Champions, in Girls Tennis and Girls Swimming

These are just a few examples of the ways that we continue to provide an exceptional educational experience that enables students to thrive. Thank you for your belief in and commitment to the mission of Saint Joseph High School. May God bless you abundantly.

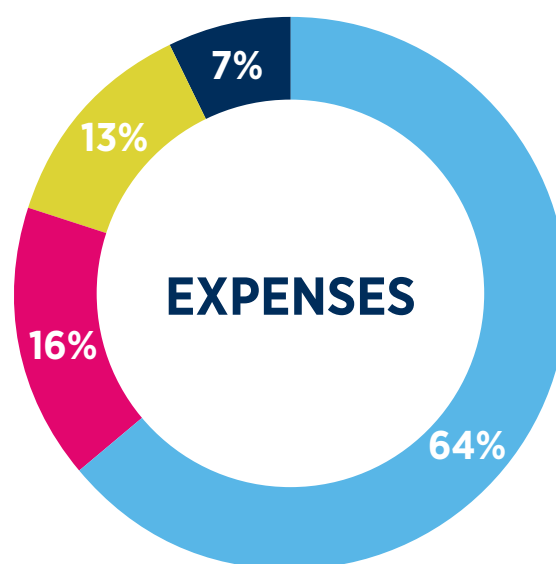
