



**Title I
Parent Involvement Plan
Parkway Manor Elementary School**

1. Parkway Manor Elementary School will involve parents in the planning, review and improvement of the school's Parent Involvement Policy by the following activities:

4. The parents at Parkway Manor Elementary will be involved in the planning, review and improvement of the school's Title I program by:

 - Offering suggestion for programmatic changes by completing surveys after each parent workshop and at the end of year.

5. Parkway Manor Elementary School will provide parents of participating children with timely information about the Title I program including:

6. Parkway Manor Elementary School will provide parents of participating children with a description and explanation of the curriculum in use at the school, the forms of academic assessment used to measure student progress, and the proficiency levels students are expected to meet by presenting parents with the information at:

 - September Open House
 - Assessment and Curriculum found on the PSD Website
 - Parent Workshops

7. Parkway Manor Elementary School will provide assistance to parents' understanding the State's academic content standards and student achievement standards, local academic assessments and how to monitor a child's progress and work with teachers to improve the achievement of their children. Assistance will be provided:

 - Parent workshops
 - Title I website
 - RTII meetings

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8. Parkway Manor Elementary School will provide, if requested by parents, opportunities for regular meetings to formulate suggestions and to participate, as appropriate in decisions relating to the education of their children, and respond to any suggestions as soon as practicably possible by:

 - By appointment with the Reading Specialist or Title I Director
