



Upper Elementary "Going Out" Permission

In the course of their work, Elementary children often need to venture out of the classroom to gather information and materials. A "going out" can include excursions to the grocery store, post office, park, pet shop, or library. It may also be a short visit to various venues for exhibits, performances, etc. The need for these excursions often arises spontaneously. Your signature on this blanket permission slip allows your child to participate in any of these outings as they come up.

Children will be in small groups accompanied by a staff member or parent volunteer. Travel will be by foot, Tri-Met, or in insured vehicles in which children will be in age- and weight-appropriate seating wearing seat belts. If a booster seat or other device is required, please indicate your wishes below and provide it when there are outings. Parent drivers will have been subjected to a DMV/Background Check. They will have read and signed our MSB Driver Policy. Driver insurance information and a copy of their driver's license will be on file in the office.

For any trip longer than the normal school day or outside the 20-mile radius, you will receive separate information and permission slips.

My child, _____, has my permission to go on excursions within a 20-mile radius of MSB.
