

OFF-CAMPUS PROGRAMS FOR LHS JUNIORS & SENIORS

Gateway Early College (Gen Ed) Program [9909 for juniors, 9910 for seniors]

- Students can attend as a junior and/or a senior. Attend college classes at Gateway (urban campus in Covington) in the morning, attend Ludlow classes for 4th, 5th, and 6th periods.
- Tuition and e-books are paid for. Laptop provided.
- Must have 3.0 GPA, good attendance history
- Must provide own transportation, but TANK pass is given to all students (your ID card)
- Juniors: Psychology, Intro to Music, US History, Biology at Gateway // English III, Math, Elective at LHS
- Seniors: English 101 & 102, Math, Speech at Gateway // Any additional requirements, Electives at LHS

Gateway Information Technology Program [9912]

- Students can attend as a junior and/or senior. Attend college classes at Gateway (urban campus in Covington) in the morning, attend Ludlow classes for 4th, 5th, and 6th periods. Classes are typically on M, W, so flexibility with classes and/or online classes will be needed.
- Tuition and e-books are paid for. Laptop provided.
- Have 2.0 GPA, good attendance history, must be in good credit standing
- Must provide own transportation, but TANK pass is given to all students (your ID card)
- Courses include Computer Hardware & Software, Cyber Security, Networking

Gateway Supply Chain & Logistics Management Program [9914]

- Students can attend as a senior. Attend college classes at Gateway (urban campus in Covington) in the morning, attend Ludlow classes for 4th, 5th, and 6th periods.
- Tuition and e-books are paid for. Laptop provided.
- Have 2.0 GPA, good attendance history, must be in good credit standing
- Must provide own transportation, but TANK pass is given to all students (your ID card)
- FALL: Courses include Introduction to Logistics Management, Supply Chain Management
- SPRING: Co-op FOR PAY with a local company, possibly near the airport (will need to meet their requirements, which may include passing a drug test); average pay is \$14.00/hour

Gateway Auto Technology Program [9911]

- Students can attend as a junior and/or a senior. Attend college classes at Gateway (3L campus in Ft. Wright) in the morning, attend Ludlow classes for 4th, 5th, and 6th periods.
- Tuition and e-books are paid for. Laptop provided.
- Have 2.0 GPA, good attendance history, must be in good credit standing
- Courses include steering systems, brake systems, electrical systems – will get dirty!

Gateway Allied Health Program [9915]

- Students can attend as a junior and/or senior. Attend college classes at Gateway (urban campus in Covington) in the morning, attend Ludlow classes for 4th, 5th, and 6th periods.
- Tuition and e-books are paid for. Laptop provided.
- Have 2.0 GPA, good attendance history, must be in good credit standing
- Must provide own transportation, but TANK pass is given to all students (your ID card)
- Perfect for anyone considering a healthcare-related career. Courses include Intro to Healthcare Careers, Medical Ethics, Terminology, and CNA certification; requires a background check and TB test at family's cost

Gateway Advanced Manufacturing Program [9917]

- Students can attend as a junior and/or a senior. Attend college classes at Gateway (urban campus in Covington) in the morning, attend Ludlow classes for 4th, 5th, and 6th periods.
- Tuition and e-books are paid for. Laptop provided.
- Have 2.0 GPA, good attendance history, must be in good credit standing
- Courses include computerized manufacturing, electrical technologies, and industrial maintenance

Skilled Trades Training Program (Combination of High School & Gateway Courses) [9916]

- Students can attend as a senior. Attend classes on a different high school's campus in the morning (possibly Newport HS), attend Ludlow classes for 4th, 5th, and 6th periods.
- Must have good attendance history, must be in good credit standing
- Exposure to skilled trades, with a focus on carpentry
- Must provide own transportation

Building Industry Association Program in Erlanger (not a Gateway program) [9913]

- Students can attend as a junior and/or a senior. Attend classes on their campus in the morning, attend Ludlow classes for 4th, 5th, and 6th periods.
- Must have good attendance history, must be in good credit standing
- Variety of construction courses and exposure in the junior year; Co-op opportunities in your area of interest during the senior year
- Must provide own transportation
