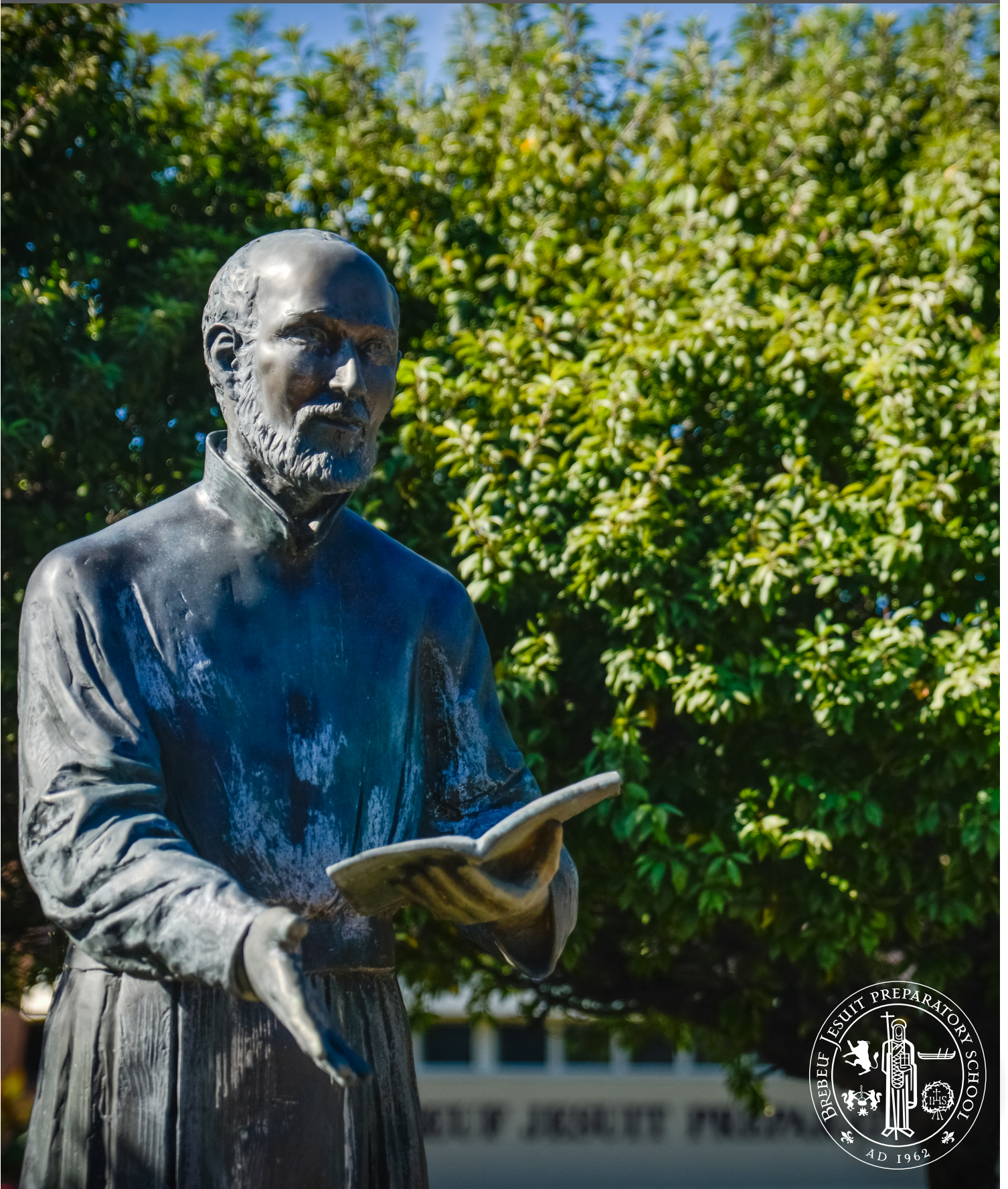

Employment Opportunity - Director of Alumni and Philanthropic Engagement

Brebeuf Jesuit Preparatory School, a 9-12 Catholic Jesuit school that provides an outstanding college preparatory education in the Jesuit tradition seeks an Director of Alumni and Philanthropic Engagement that is willing to work collaboratively with other members of the Brebeuf Jesuit community to continue molding students into *men and women for others*.

Brebeuf Jesuit actively seeks to increase the diversity of its faculty and develop an inclusive community, therefore underrepresented candidates are encouraged to apply.

The Director of Alumni and Philanthropic Engagement is a member of the Advancement team and is responsible for securing financial resources for Brebeuf Jesuit Preparatory School. The primary focus is meeting and working with donors and prospects with significant giving capacity to accomplish their giving objectives in the form of annual giving, major and planned gifts. The Director of Alumni and Philanthropic Engagement will be responsible for all aspects of the donor development cycle including donor identification, cultivation, solicitation, acknowledgment, and stewardship.

This position reports to the Senior Vice President.

RESPONSIBILITIES

(Note: The following list of responsibilities is not exhaustive. Others may be assigned, subject to reasonable accommodations.)

- In collaboration with the Senior Vice President; Director of Development, and other Advancement colleagues, develops the goals, strategies, and tasks associated with alumni relations, major gifts, and the planned giving program for Brebeuf Jesuit.
- Responsible for qualifying, cultivating, soliciting, and/or stewarding a portfolio of 100 alumni major gift prospects.
- In coordination with other Advancement team members, develop written proposals, gift agreements and other appropriate correspondence necessary to acquire gifts and commitments.
- Manage the planned giving program and the stewardship of the O'Brien Society.
- Attend events, travel as necessary locally and regionally to manage a portfolio of prospects effectively.
- Support and cultivate the work of the Alumni Association Board of Directors in the areas of governance, communication, awards, and events.
- Collaborate and participate in the management of programs and operations for strategic initiatives to engage alumni constituencies.
