## Virtual Learning Academy of St. Clair County (VLA) Board of Education Policy

## Amended **Prohibition of Referral or Assistance Policy**

A school official, board member, or employee of the Virtual Learning Academy of St. Clair County shall not refer a student for an abortion or assist a student in obtaining an abortion. This prohibition does not apply to a person who is the parent or legal guardian of that student.

If a parent or legal guardian of a student enrolled in the Virtual Learning Academy of St. Clair County believes a Virtual Learning Academy of St. Clair County school official, board member, or employee has violated this Policy, he or she may file a complaint with the Superintend/Chief Administrator, who will investigate the complaint, and within 30 days after the date of the complaint, provide a written report of his or her finding to the complaint and to the Superintended of public instruction in accordance with State Law. If a violation is substantiated, the Superintend/Chief Administrator or the Board will discipline that person in accordance with Board Policy and applicable collective bargaining agreement or employment contract. The Superintendent/Chief Administrator will take corrective action to ensure that there is no further violation.
