





CREATE AN ACCOUNT:

- Username (student chooses)
- Email Address (use student's personal email-NOT school email)
- Password (students chooses within guidelines)

Write down and save your username and password!



- Majority of applications open August 1st
- Used for every Texas public university and two-year schools, plus many private colleges and universities in Texas.
- Completion instructions are available online and clear to understand.
- Used for multiple universities.
- Submit one application in full, then copy that submitted application to another institution.
- Streamlines the application process.
- Be sure to complete and submit the Scholarship Application.



ApplyTexas instructions state you can submit your resume separately - check with each institution before doing this

PRIORITY ORDER:

- Extracurricular Activities
- -Community or Volunteer Service
- -Talents, awards, and honors
- -Employment, internships and Summer Acitivites.

ESSAY TOPICS

Topic A

Tell us your story. What unique opportunities or challenges have you experienced throughout your high school career that have shaped who you are today?

Topic B

Some students have an identity, an interest, or a talent that defines them in an essential way. If you are one of those students, tell us about yourself.

Topic C

You've got a ticket in your hand

- Where will you go? What
will you do? What will happen
when you get there?

"Required" - vs - "Optional"
Write an essay...even when listed as "Optional"

** Be mindful! Each school requires a different combination of these essays – some require all three, some just one or two, and other make certain ones recommended or optional. Some schools even use these essays for admissions decisions AND scholarships. Be sure to you click on the "Special Instructions" link under your application details for additional requirements.

ESSAY TOPICS

- Each university/college may have different essay requirements.
- Essays are submitted electronically through ApplyTexas and are sent to the admissions and scholarship offices.
- Type your essay on a Word document first. You can copy & paste it into the ApplyTexas document.
- Pay attention to any word limit or character line limits.
- Review your essay to ensure the completed essay is included before submitting.
- Admissions essays do not have to be submitted at the same time as the rest of the application. They can be sent later using the "My Essays" tab.


When Writing Your Essays & Answering Your Short Answer Questions ...

- •Don't complicate your answers! Don't overwrite.
- •They want to get to know you ...who you are, where you come from, what your interests & goals are, etc.

Submitted Application

Once an application is submitted on ApplyTexas, it is considered complete and may not be changed in any way on the ApplyTexas site.

• A message and check box will pop up and the student must check the box before an application may be submitted.



Some colleges and universities will allow students to make changes once their application has been processed by the school. To request a change to an application, students should contact the admissions office at the school applied to for assistance and advice.

Submitted Application

Each application will be assigned a unique application ID number.

This number will be required for any communication concerning that application.
