# From the Director's Desk

It is quite hard to believe that in one more month we will have been in the new building for a year! We opened on September 20 after a quick move, and we're still trying to get Google Maps to send people to the new address! This complex had been a dream for us for quite a few years. The Board of Selectmen appointed a Library Exploratory Committee in 2012 to look at options for an expanded, handicap accessible building and we received the promise of a \$1 million grant from the State Library. After exploring multiple locations and possibilities (expand onsite, demolish and rebuild onsite, locations such as the armory/end of the plaza) we went to referendum in 2013 to purchase the parcel next to the synagogue on Church Street. The referendum failed by 12 votes and the idea languished until 2015 when the Facility Committee proposed the idea of a complex with multiple entities. We were able to extend the state grant until the municipal complex referendum was successful. We could not predict that COVID would hit right before the groundbreaking in the spring of 2020 but that didn't stop or slow down our construction company. They were able to source materials and schedule workers despite the supply chain troubles and the project was completed in the fall of 2021. We are very happy to be in the complex with our Town Hall and Aspinock Society colleagues, and the multi-tasking works out very well for library visitors when they need to transact business or have a senior meal!
