1. Complete application with all documents and items of support.
2. Biographical essay (100 words/full page minimum typed).
3. Two letters of recommendation, from teachers, administrators, or coaches that includes comments about academic/scholarship, community service, civic engagement, musical, dance, fine art or theatrical participation and citizenship.

Completed applications must be posted marked no later than Friday, March 11, 2022.
