

Aquaculture

Captain Billy Rotne, a professional aquaculturist and member of the Citizen Advisory Committee for the Indian River Lagoon National Estuary Program spoke with NSBHS Aquaculture 2,3,4 students on February 26 about opportunities in aquaculture and restoration. His future role with NSBHS includes working with the NSBHS aquaculture students at the Marine Discovery Center. The future plans for Marine Discovery Center include live coral propagation, Berghia nudibranch culturing, and husbandry of native species of reef estuarine fish. These initiatives are critical in fostering the seeds of conservation in future generations of stakeholders and leading a path for restoring both our local estuary, the Indian River Lagoon, as well as larger scopes of worldwide reef restoration and aquaculture to support the commercial seafood industry. This type of curriculum helps students understand the impact they can have in both the world of academia and the private sector, both of which are equally important for the future of our marine environments both locally and worldwide.



Testing

There is a lot of testing that happens at the high school level. Florida State Assessments, EOC's, PERT, ACT NCR, just to name a few. We are happy to announce the addition of the PSAT for 9th grade students and the in-school SAT for juniors and seniors. Juniors will be taking the SAT in school this year April 10th. Next year, seniors will take the SAT in the fall and juniors will take it in the spring. Our 9th grade students will be taking the PSAT as well in the fall. These tests will be given at no charge. This means that beginning in 9th grade, our students will take some version a College Board test designed to promote college readiness each year in school.




