

Never forget testing dates again! Sign up for notifications using the Remind app. Open a browser in your Android or Smartphone and type in rmd.at/nsbtesting. Enter your name and phone number to sign up for testing notifications throughout the year.

- No phone? Open a browser on a computer and enter: rmd.at/nsbtesting.

Push notifications will be sent prior to every test administration. You can always access the testing calendar by visiting the testing page on the school's website.
