


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Journey Through The Galapagos

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Twelve Angry Actors Take the Stage

The New Smyrna High theatre department is proud to present Reginald Rose's classic courtroom drama "Twelve Angry Jurors", adapted for the stage by Sherman Sergel. The play concerns the deliberations of the jury of a homicide trial where a dozen "men with ties" decides the fate of a teenager accused of murdering his abusive father. At the beginning, they have a nearly unanimous decision of guilty, with a single dissenter of not guilty, who throughout the play sows a seed of reasonable doubt.

The show will run from October 11-13 at 7pm in the NSBHS Auditorium. Tickets are \$10 for general admission, \$5 for students and faculty are free.
