

PARENT IN MILITARY

Parent in Military is a student characteristic indicating the student has a parent or guardian who is a member of the armed forces on active duty, serves full-time National Guard duty, or is a traditional member of the National Guard or Reserve. Parent in Military is a self-reported data element from a student's parents. If a family chooses to change what is self-reported, they can do so at any time. DPI recommends schools collect this data element only once at the initial enrollment of a student and recommends an annual update at the start of each school year during the student's educational career.
