## **Attendance**

This is an essential part of the learning experience; As teachers, we need students here every day to facilitate the learning process. It is very difficult to be successful in school if you are not in attendance. Considering the pace at which high school classes progress, students who miss school find it difficult to remain on track and achieve. It is expected that every student does their best to attend school each and every day. Should an event take place that would prevent a student from attending, informing your teachers as soon as possible is the best approach. Teacher emails are listed on the first page of this paper.

## **Homework**

This is another important part of the learning process. Homework serves several different purposes including assisting students in the mastery of class content as well as a communication tool between home and school. Homework is a teacher's first line of assessment and allows for immediate intervention. At Canton South High School, homework is routinely assigned and graded which results in students achieving at higher levels. Below are the expectations for students, parents, and teachers with regard to homework.

### **Student**

- Keep up-to-date, clarify with the teacher any instructions not understood, and turn work in on the due date.

### **Parent**

- Assume your student will have assignments daily and make sure your student has the necessary supplies (if anything is needed please contact the school).
- Help your student get organized, check grades often through Home Access Center and watch for signs of failure or frustration (contact your student's teachers to clear up any misunderstandings, troubleshoot problems, discuss time management, and be informed).

### **Teacher**

- State clearly the purpose of the assignment and explain how the assignment is related to the topic of study.
- Provide feedback in a timely manner and use the results of homework to plan future instructional activities.
- Homework is included as part of the student's overall grade.

## **Cell Phones and other electronic devices**

### **Cell Phones:**

- Students' cell phones are to be turned off, kept out of sight, (not observable), and not used during the school day. Violation of this rule will result in disciplinary action and immediate confiscation of the cell phone. The phone will be placed in a bag and tagged with the student's name. A second offense will require a parent to pick up the cell phone from the assistant principal's office and loss all hall pass privileges. Any further violations may result in suspension and/or loss of other privileges. Contents of cell phones may be searched if there exists a reasonable suspicion that it may have been used in an activity that violated the code of conduct. The student will be notified if there is a reasonable suspicion to search the phone.

### **Technological Devices:**

- Devices with capabilities of voice or text communication, pictorial or graphic capabilities, or the capability of electronically storing information are prohibited unless being used in an authorized curricular or co-curricular capacity and permission is given. Students are responsible for the content on all electronic devices in their possession. Inappropriate pictures, songs, phrases, etc... may result in disciplinary action.

### **Headsets:**

- AirPods/earbuds, Headphones, iPods, etc. are prohibited in the hallways and classes unless being used in an authorized curricular or co-curricular capacity and/or permission is given.
