

AIR FORCE JUNIOR ROTC (OK-942) GRADING PLAN AY 2023

Grading policy is based on the traditional format as a percentage of total points earned:

Academics: About 75% of the JROTC grade will be derived from the Aerospace Science (AS), Leadership Education (LE) and Physical Training/Wellness curriculum (PT/W). The grading weight for these subject areas is 40%, 40% and 20% respectively, per USAF JROTC curriculum directive. A total of 2000 academic points can be earned for this school year.

Extra Credit: All cadets are offered the opportunity to obtain extra credit. Extra credit opportunities will be afforded based on events, JROTC cadet command needs, JROTC program needs and individual student coordination with instructors. A total of 200 extra credit points can be earned for school year 2022/23.
