Communication to Families

Informational and emergency communication occurs via Constant Contact, Sendit, and our Bright Arrow phone and email system. We send emails, texts, and voice messages throughout the year. Be sure to check your promotions, junk mail, and spam folders if you are not receiving emails.

Freshman Day

The first day of school for 9th graders is Wednesday, August 31, a day for **Freshmen only.** This day is designed to help ease the transition from 8th grade and is full of activities to help Freshmen become acquainted with FHS. All buses run on the regular time schedule. This is a regular school day and attendance will be taken. Classes that would regularly meet off campus or at the Ag Center meet in the Commons.

Student ID

All students are provided a student identification card at no charge. Students may use last year's ID until they are issued a new student ID after picture day. Students who do not have an ID card can use their student ID number found on their schedule until they receive an ID. IDs come from the school pictures, taken on September 12 & 13.

Athletics

FHS Booster Club

Lunch Account

Students can deposit money into their account at the cafeteria and then purchase food by accessing their account. Free and reduced lunch forms are available at the cafeteria or in the main office, and all information is kept confidential.

School Pictures

School pictures for grades 9, 10, and 11 are on September 12 & 13 in the high school auditorium foyer. If a student does not plan on purchasing a class picture, they still need to have their photo taken in order to receive a student ID and be included in the yearbook. Dress code applies; ask at the main office if you have questions. Senior portraits for the yearbook are due November 22, 2022. Information can be found in the Student Handbook.

Parking Permits

All students parking on school property during school hours are required to display a parking permit. Permits are issued free of charge (first permit ONLY) at the FHS office at the beginning of the school year. Students must bring a current vehicle registration in order to secure a parking permit. If you obtained a permit last year, it is valid for the current year. Permits are non-transferable between vehicles. There is a \$5.00 replacement fee for lost or additional permits. Flathead parking permits are not valid in the residential parking district. Residential parking permits are available at City of Kalispell offices.

Flathead Parent Group

Interested in getting involved at FHS? The Flathead Parent Group meets a few times each year, with their first meeting Wednesday, September 7, at 12:00 noon in the FHS conference room. The Parent Group is a volunteer organization whose mission is to encourage and support the student body, staff, and families of FHS. In addition to providing staff appreciation, student birthday candy bars, and other supports, this group hosts parent education events on topics relevant to raising teens.
