### **Important Dates**

- All Final Forms must be signed, and physicals up to date w/ athletic office or head coach. Please be sure to register your student for their sports and activities on Final Forms ASAP.

- **August 8th: Mandatory OHSAA fall sports parent meeting at 7pm in the HS auditorium.**
- August 9th: HS/MS Fall sports picture day.
  - Students will receive their picture forms and time from their head coach this week.
- August 9th: HS mandatory baseline drug testing day... no exceptions can be given aside from AD or HS Principal.
  - All HS drivers, HS FFA, HS extracurricular music, and fall HS sport athletes are required to report for drug testing. Walk-in hours are from 10-11:15am, or 2:30-3:15pm. During this time, HS Drivers, non-marching band music members, and FFA should report to the main office for testing.
  - Sports teams & marching bands will be given a specific time slot arranged near their picture times for the day. Head coaches/advisers will communicate these times.
  - **Testing is \$17- please bring cash or check made payable to River Valley High School.**
- September 1st: Half of fall extracurricular fees are due.
  - HS FEES:
    - 1 sport \$200, 2nd sport \$50, 3rd sport \$25
    - Music fee \$106
    - Combo fee \$325 (cap for multi-sport & music students)
  - MS FEES:
    - 1 sport \$95, 2nd sport \$25, 3rd sport \$10
  - FAMILY CAP (HS and/or MS):
    - \$550
  - Fees reduced 50% for free lunch students.

### **All Sports Passes**

- Beginning August 8th, sports passes will be for sale in the HS office Monday-Friday, 8am-3pm.
  - HS/MS all sports family pass: \$360
    - Up to 6, must be family (larger families, contact Travis or Susie).
  - Adult single all sports pass: \$150

- Student single all sports pass: \$90
- Full payment is required at time of registration, cash accepted or checks made payable to River Valley Athletics.
- There will be a short application to fill out.
- Pass list members will have a numbered card that must be presented at each game.
  - No pass=pay regular entry fee.
- Passes are non-transferable.

### Senior Citizen Passes

- Beginning August 8th, senior citizen passes (age 60+) will be available for pickup in the HS office. Senior citizens will receive a plastic card this year to present at all RV home games for free admission. **Seniors who picked up a pass last year do not need to come back this year... senior citizen passes do not expire.**
  - Must be a resident of the RV local school district.
    - PLEASE BRING PROOF OF ADDRESS OR ID w/ CURRENT ADDRESS TO RECEIVE YOUR PASS.
  - These will also be available for pickup at the first home football game.

### Eligibility

- Once we receive finalized rosters, students will be evaluated for scholastic eligibility based on the end of the 4th 9-weeks from last school year, meaning:
  - High school student-athletes will need to have passed the equivalent of 5 credits while maintaining a 1.0GPA.
  - Incoming 8th grade student-athletes will need to have passed 4 classes during last year's 4th 9-weeks.
  - Incoming 7th grade student-athletes are all academically eligible to start the year, and will be evaluated at the end of first 9-weeks.
