### <u>Pre-K</u>

3 glue sticks

Pencils (#2) – 24 any brand/design (NO mechanical) Crayons - (2 packs) 16 or 24 count crayons Glue -3 Elmer's JUMBO glue sticks (preferably disappearing purple glue) Scissors – 1 pair of child scissors Pencil Box (NO zipper pouches) Sticky Notes - 1 pack, any color (recommend: 3 in. x 3 in. or larger) Dry Erase Markers – 4 Low odor THIN dry erase markers, any color Composition Books - 3 MEAD PRIMARY 100 sheet story journal (usually blue with blank on top for picture, lined on the bottom for writing) – try Walmart, Target, or Staples

Erasers – 1 three pack of Pink Pearl Erasers Highlighters - 2 any color Boys – 1 box of FREEZER GALLON size plastic baggies and 1 pack of baby wipes Girls – 1 box of plastic quart plastic baggies and 1 bottle of hand sanitizer Water Bottle – 1 reusable plastic water bottle
