Students will receive 225 hours of instruction per year, for a total of 900 hours, while attending class two nights per week from the end of August to the following June. Classes will offer both theory and limited hands-on training. Upon successful completion of the entire program, New York State Registered Electrical Apprentices will be qualified as journey workers. 
