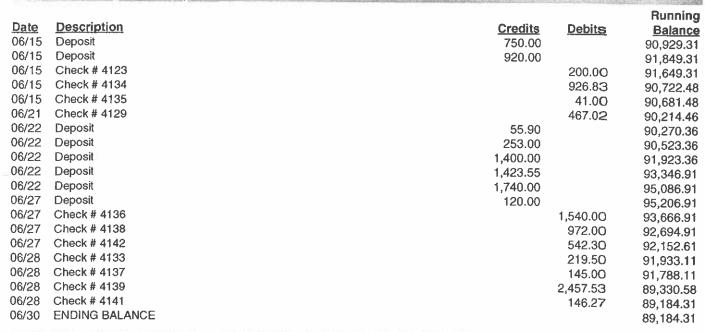

SERVICE AGREEMENT

THIS SERVICES AGREEMENT (the "Agreement"), dated this 25th of May 2022, by and between GENEVA GENERAL HOSPITAL (the "Provider"), the by and between SENECA FALLS CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT (the "District").

WHEREAS. The Provider offers various health services; and

WHEREAS, the District is in need of the services of a licensed and certified athletic trainer (the "Trainer") to provide athletic training services to students participating in the District's athletic programs, and those programs are described on the attached Exhibit A (the "Services"); and

WHEREAS, the Provider desires to provide Services in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. **Provider's Obligation**

- a) The provider will provide the Services on a non-exclusive basis for up to on a scheduled basis in agreement with the school athletic director, during no more than five (5) days per week, at times and placed determined in advance by the parties. The Provider will be the District's exclusive provider for the Services.
- b) Services will begin to be provided on and after August 1st, 2022 (the "Effective Date").
- c) The Trainer, who will begin the Services, will be employed by the Provider and will be a New York licensed and certified athletic trainer. The Trainer will be supported by the Provider's orthopedic program, its hospital based physical therapy program, and its physician and clinical practices located in the Seneca Falls area. The Services will be provided in accordance with applicable standards of care and applicable state and federal laws and regulations ("the Applicable Laws").

2. District's Obligation

The District will provide the Provider with information relating to the District's athletic programs and activities, and the coaches and students who will be participating in those programs and activities and for whom the Trainer may be required to provide Services. In addition, the District will provide such medical equipment and supplies as requested by the Provider. The District's physician will serve as the supervising physician for the Trainer to the extent necessary to comply with Applicable Laws.

3. <u>Compensation and Terms of Payment</u>

- a) The District will pay Provider a fee of seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000.00) for the period ending July 31, 2023, which fee shall be payable in equal monthly installments on the first day of each month. The Provider will invoice the District monthly.
- b) Terms of payment will be net thirty (30) days after the District receives an invoice. Invoices will be deemed received three (3) business days after being mailed by the provider. Payment will be considered made when payment checks are mailed or an electronic funds transfer is initiated. Late payments are subject to a one-and-a-half percent (1.5%) per annum penalty.
- c) It is anticipated that, with respect to some of the Services, Provider will be able to bill an insurance company for those Services. Any revenue received by the Provider after having billed an insurance company and/or parent of the student will be the property of the Provider.

4. Records and Reporting

The Provider and the District are concerned about maintaining the privacy of all student-patient data, particularly medical records. The Provider will retain the ownership of all student-patient medical records prepared by Provider while preforming the Services. These records will be retained by Provider, during and after term of this Agreement, and the District will have access to such records and information, all in accordance with Applicable Laws.

5. Relationship of the Parties

The Provider is an independent contractor of the District under this Agreement, and neither party is considered an employee, partner or agent of the other party. Neither party has the authority to act as agent for or to bind the other party in any way. The parties will report for tax purposes in a manner required by consistent with the terms of Agreement.

6. <u>Insurance</u>

a) The Provider will obtain and maintain, at its sole cost and expense, occurrence based, comprehensive general liability insurance and professional malpractice insurance. The insurance will be secured from a carrier authorized to do business in New York State. The Professional malpractice insurance will have coverage limits of at least one million three hundred thousand dollars (\$1,300,000) per occurrence and three million nine hundred thousand dollars (\$3,900,000) annual aggregate, and the general liability insurance will have coverage limits of at least five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) per occurrence and one million dollars (\$1,000,000) annual aggregate.

b) The Provider will provide District evidence of the insurance required under this section as of the Effective Date, and as may otherwise be requested by the District from time to time.

7. <u>Indemnification</u>

- a) The District will indemnify and hold harmless the Provider and its officers, managers, directors, shareholders, members, employees and agents, and their heirs, successors and assigns of each of the foregoing, from and against any and all liabilities, losses, damages, claims, causes of action, cost and expenses (including reasonable legal fees) caused, directly or indirectly, by or as a result of any act or omission of the District.
- b) The Provider will indemnify and hold harmless the District and its officers, managers, directors, shareholders, members, employees and agents and the heirs, successors and assigns of each of the foregoing, from and against any and all liabilities, losses, damages, claims, causes of action, cost and expenses (including reasonable legal fees) caused, directly or indirectly, by or as a result of any act or omission of the Provider.
- c) The party reasonably believes that it is entitled to indemnification under this Section, or otherwise receives notice of the assertion or commencement of any third-party claim, action or proceeding with respect to which the other party may be obligated under this Section, then the party seeking indemnification will, within twenty (20) days thereafter, give written notice of such claim for indemnification. The delivery of the notice shall be a condition precedent to any liability for indemnification under this Section.
 - d) This Section 7 will survive the termination of this Agreement.

8. <u>Compliance</u>

It is not a purpose, nor is it a requirement of this Agreement or any other agreement among the parties, to offer or receive any remuneration or benefit of any nature to solicit, induce, require or encourage the referral of any patient the payment for which may be made in whole or in part by the Medicare or Medicaid programs or otherwise. Neither party will make or receive any payment that would be prohibited under Applicable Laws. No part of this Agreement will be construed to induce or encourage the referral of patients or the purchase of health care services or supplies. The parties acknowledge that there is no requirement under this Agreement or any other agreement between the parties that any party refer any patient to any health care provider or purchase any health care goods or services from any source. Additionally, no payment under this Agreement is in return for the referral of patients, or in return for purchasing, leasing or ordering services from a party, or any of the party's affiliates. The parties may refer patients to any company or person providing Services and will make such referrals, if any, consistent with professional medical judgment and the needs and wished of the relevant parties. Each party will promptly notify the other party of any investigation alleging a violation of law which may affect this Agreement.

b) Both parties will comply with all Applicable Laws; with applicable ethical and professional standards; and with currently accepted and approved methods and practices.

9. <u>Term and Termination</u>

- a) This Agreement shall be for a term ending on July 31, 2023 unless sooner terminated in accordance with the terms of this Agreement. Sixty (60) days prior to July 31, 2023, the Provider will review and determine whether if it wants to increase the fee amount for the second year. If the parties cannot agree on a new fee amount, the Provider has the option to continue to provide services for the \$17,000.00 fee amount or terminate this Agreement.
- b) Either party may terminate this Agreement for cause on thirty (30) days prior written notice, during which notice period the cause may be cured. Either party may terminate this Agreement without cause on sixty (60) days prior written notice.

10. <u>Severability</u>

Every provision of this Agreement is intended to be severable. If any provision is held to be invalid or unenforceable by law or by a court of competent jurisdiction, all other provisions will nevertheless continue in full force and effect. In lieu of such invalid or unenforceable provision, there will be added to this Agreement a legal, valid and enforceable provision as similar in terms to such invalid or unenforceable provision as may be possible.

11. <u>Miscellaneous</u>

The following provisions will apply to this Agreement:

- a) The paragraph headings contained in this Agreement have been prepared for convenience of reference only and will not control, affect the meaning, or be taken as an interpretation of any provision of this Agreement.
- b) Several copies of this Agreement may be executed by the parties, each of which are deemed an original for all purposes, and all of which together constitute but one and the same instrument.
- c) In the event any term or condition of this Agreement is breached by either party and thereafter waived by the other party, then such waiver will be limited to the particular breach so waived and is not deemed to waive any other breach either prior or subsequent to the breach so waived.
- d) If the consent of either party is required for whatever reason under the terms of this Agreement, such consent will not be unreasonably withheld, conditioned or delayed.
- e) Defined terms referenced in the recitals set forth above are incorporated into and made a part of this Agreement.

12. Failure to Performance

If a dispute arises with respect to the performance by either party of any of its obligations under the terms of this Agreement, or if a dispute arises with respect to the interpretation of this Agreement, a party will have the right, at its election, to commence a legal action and to sue for damages for such breach and to seek such legal and equitable remedies as may be available to it. In any such action, the prevailing party will be entitled to recover all reasonable expenses, which shall include reasonable legal fees and courts costs, incurred: (a) to sue for damages; (b) to seek such other legal and equitable remedies; and (c) to collect any damages and enforce any court order or settlement agreement including, but not limited to, additional application to the court for an order of contempt. Nothing contained herein shall be construed to restrict or impair the rights of either party to exercise this election. All rights and remedies herein provided or existing at law or in equity shall be cumulative of each other and may be enforced concurrently therewith or from time to time.

13. Notices

Any notice or other communication which is required to be given under the terms of this Agreement will be in writing and delivered personally, or sent by registered mail, or by certified mail return receipt requested. Any notice which is mailed will be deemed to have been given on the second business day after the day of mailing (not counting the day mailed), irrespective of the date of receipt. Notices may be signed and given by the attorney for the party sending the notice. A new address may be designated by notice.

14. <u>Construction</u>

All understanding and agreements previously made by and between the parties are merged in this Agreement, which alone fully and completely expresses their agreement. This Agreement may not be changed, terminated nor any of its provisions modified or waived, except in writing signed by all the parties of the Agreement.

15. Applicable Law; Jurisdiction; Venue

COOPERATIVE COUNSELING AGREEMENT BETWEEN COMMUNITY COUNSELING CENTER OF SENECA COUNTY AND

SENECA FALLS CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT (Substance Abuse)

This agreement will be in effect for the period of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023. It is made between the Community Counseling Center of Seneca County (hereinafter the "Center") and the Seneca Falls Central School District (hereinafter the "School)

-OBJECTIVES-

The objectives of the Agreement are as follows:

- 1. To provide direct access to educational and counseling resources to school age youth and their families of the School for the purpose of educating, assessing and counseling in the area of substance/chemical abuse problems; and
- 2. To provide coordination, education, and inservice training to School personnel and community agencies in the areas of substance/chemical abuse, and mandated reporting in order to promote and educate school staff; and to facilitate early and efficient entry by School youths and their families to counseling services, at a cost of \$49,500; and

-PROVISION OF SERVICE-

Services provided pursuant to this Agreement shall meet the standards set forth by the New York State Office of Addiction Services and Supports, in order to assure proper licensing. Services provided shall include direct counseling of youths at the School, as well as classroom/community based services to youths of the School and their families and related community activities. Services rendered are defined as ten (10) full-time equivalent days of service per week while school is in session provided by staff of the Community Counseling Center of Seneca County with the title "Substance Abuse Counselor". The School shall provide appropriate working space for the services rendered, and shall grant access to limited communications. The Center shall be responsible for the allocation and coordination of services rendered, and any problems which may arise as a result of the provision of services shall be promptly referred to the Director of the Center, in writing.

-RECORDS-

Appropriate clinical records shall be maintained by the Center and shall be kept at its main office. Confidentiality shall be governed by Title 42 of the Codes of Federal Regulations, Part Two. In order to allow for the flow of information between the Center and the School, "Release of Information" forms shall be requested from all individuals receiving services, authorizing the transfer of information between the Center and the School, and their respective personnel.

-FUNDING-

The School agrees to pay the Center the sum of \$49,500.00 (Forty-nine thousand, five hundred dollars) for the services provided herein. All funds shall be allocated to the Center on a quarterly basis in equal amounts of \$12,375 (Twelve thousand, three hundred seventy five dollars) for each quarter payable on or about July 1, 2022, October 1, 2022, January 1, 2023, April 1, 2023.

This Agreement shall have effect only to the extent that said funds and other necessary resources are appropriated or otherwise made available by state and local governmental authorities, and the School.

Except as provided in the preceding paragraph, no fees shall be charged for the services pursuant to this Agreement. Neither party assumes any liabilities incurred by the other in connection with the execution of this Agreement.

MEDICAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS MEDICAL SERVICES AGREEMENT (the "Agreement"), dated this 4th day of

August 2022, by and between Soldiers and Sailors Memorial Hospital, a New York not-for-profit hospital having an address at 418 North Main Street, Penn Yan, NY 14527 (the "Provider"), and Seneca Falls Central School District, having an address at 98 Clinton Street, Seneca Falls, New York 13148 (the "District").

WHEREAS, the Provider owns and operates medical facilities and offers various health services throughout the upstate New York region; and

WHEREAS, the District has a student health infirmary on its campus and requires licensed medical professionals to provide health care services and administrative oversight (the "Services"); and

WHEREAS, the Provider desires to provide the Services in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. Provider's Obligation

- (a) Provider will provide health related services on a non-exclusive basis on the District's campus for up to four (4) hours per week at such times as both Provider and District agree. Provider will provide a school physician Licensed in the State of New York or other New York State licensed Advanced Care Practitioner to perform services to perform services outlined in **Exhibit A-School Physician Services**.
- (b) Prior to the Effective Date, Provider will obtain and maintain at Provider's expense the insurance set forth in <u>Section 7.</u>
- (c) Provider's employees who are providing Services to the District will at all times be properly licensed in New York State, and the Services will be provided in accordance with applicable standards of care and applicable state and federal laws and regulations (the "Applicable Laws").

2. <u>District's Obligation</u>

- (a) District will furnish Provider with facilities, office furniture, medical equipment, and medical supplies (the "Facilities") at the campus as are reasonably necessary for Provider to provide the Services. Initially, the equipment within the Facilities is adequate for the contracted Services. Should an identified need for such items become evident, District and the Provider will discuss the needs and mutually agree to take steps reasonably necessary to bring the Facilities up to the standards for care.
- (b) District will provide all utilities, maintenance, and housekeeping services for the Clinic. District will also provide Provider with access to a secure high speed internet connection, phone, and fax lines at no charge to the Provider.

3. Compensation and Terms

- (a) District will pay Thirty-Seven Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-two dollars and 50 cents (\$37,852.50) annually, or Three Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty-Five dollars and 25 cents (\$3,785.25) in 10 monthly payments (September through June) for Services provided (the Fees). Provider's expense for malpractice insurance, benefits, travel, and administrative costs are built into the Fees. Provider will invoice the District monthly for all Services provided during the preceding month.
- (b) School bus driver physicals meeting New York State Department of Transportation standards will be billed at a rate of Twenty Five dollars (\$25.00) each. Provider will invoice the District monthly for any DOT physicals performed in the preceding month. Invoices will come from FLH Medical, PC. A sister company to the Provider
- (c) Terms of payment will be net thirty (30) days after District receives an invoice. Invoices will be deemed received three (3) business days after being mailed by Provider. Payment will be considered made when payment checks are mailed or an electronic funds transfer is initiated. Late payments are subject to a one-and-a-half (1.5%) percent penalty and will accrue interest at the maximum amount permitted by law.

4. Term and Termination

- (a) This Agreement is effective August 1, 2022 (the "Effective Date"). The term is effective for one (1) year beginning on the Effective Date and terminates July 31, 2023. If at the end of the term neither party has expressed interest in negotiating a new Agreement, Agreement will renew annually on August 1st for a term of one (1) year with a 3% annual fee increase from the preceding school year.
- (b) Either party may terminate this Agreement without cause One Hundred Twenty (120) days with prior written notice. Either party may terminate this Agreement for cause on thirty (30) days prior written notice, during which notice period the cause may be cured.
- (c) Upon any termination of this Agreement the District will pay Provider the accrued but unpaid compensation owed to it hereunder.
- (d) If either party breaches any term or condition of this Agreement the non-breaching party will have the right, at any time including subsequent to the expiration or termination of this Agreement, to assess damages or to sue for damages for such breach and to seek such legal and equitable remedies as may be available to it. All rights and remedies provided in this Agreement or existing at law or in equity will be cumulative of each other and may be enforced concurrently therewith or from time to time.

5. Records and Reporting

(a) Reports for any Services provided on campus by Provider under this Agreement will be recorded and maintained by the District. Provider will retain and maintain all student, faculty, and staff medical records prepared by Provider while performing services at the Providers office in accordance with Providers medical records policies. Copies of these records for services provided at Provider's office will be provided to the District. Provider is concerned about maintaining the privacy of all student-patient data, particularly medical information. These records will be retained by Provider upon termination of the Agreement. No student-patient health information may be transferred or released without prior approval of the student-patient, or as otherwise permitted by Applicable Laws. In the event of such release or transfer, District will exercise all due care to maintain the security of Provider's data and to prevent its loss or appropriation by unauthorized individuals. Only the limitations imposed by the student-patient's medical condition and the precautions the District should institute to avoid aggravation of the student-patient condition should be disclosed, unless disclosure is authorized by the student-patient or required for public safety. First aid and safety personnel may be informed, when appropriate, if a condition might require emergency treatment.

6. Relationship of the Parties

Provider is an independent contractor of the District under this Agreement and neither party is considered an employee, partner, or agent of the other party. Neither party has the authority to act as an agent for or to bind the other party in any way. The parties will report for tax purposes in a manner required by and consistent with the terms of this Agreement.

7. <u>Insurance</u>

- (a) Provider will obtain and maintain, at its sole cost and expense, professional malpractice insurance during the term of this Agreement on an occurrence basis for each employee providing Services to the District. This professional malpractice insurance will be with a carrier authorized to do business in New York State and will have a coverage limit of at least one million (\$1,000,000) dollars per occurrence and three million (\$3,000,000) dollars in the annual aggregate.
- (b) Provider will provide District evidence of the insurance required under <u>Section</u> 7(a) as of the Effective Date, and as may otherwise be requested by District from time to time.

8. Indemnification

- (a) District will indemnify, hold harmless and defend the Provider and its officers, managers, directors, shareholders, members, employees and agents, and the heirs, successors and assigns of each of the foregoing, from and against any and all liabilities, losses, damages, claims, causes of action (collectively, the "Claims") caused directly or indirectly, by or as a result of any acts or omissions of District for any breach of this Agreement to the extent that any such Claims are not compensated for by applicable insurance.
- (b) Provider will indemnify, hold harmless and defend the District and its officers, managers, directors, shareholders, members, employees and agents, and the heirs, successors and assigns of each of the foregoing, from and against any and all Claims caused, directly or indirectly, by or as a

result of any acts or omissions of the Provider and/or its employees providing Services (including, without limitation, malpractice) or any breach of this Agreement to the extent that any such Claims are not compensated for by applicable insurance.

- (c) Each party agrees to provide the other with information in its possession which is essential to the other party's defense in litigation and which is not reasonably available from another source subject to Applicable Laws of confidentiality and attorney-client privilege.
 - (d) The terms of this **Section 8** will survive the termination of this Agreement.

9. Compliance

- (a) It is not a purpose, nor is it a requirement of this Agreement or any other agreement among the parties, to offer or receive any remuneration or benefit of any nature to solicit, induce, require or encourage the referral of any patient the payment for which may be made in whole or in part by the Medicare or Medicaid programs or otherwise. Neither party will make or receive any payment that would be prohibited under Applicable Laws. No part of this Agreement will be construed to induce or encourage the referral of patients or the purchase of health care services or supplies. The parties acknowledge that there is no requirement under this Agreement or any other agreement between the parties that any party refer any patient to any health care provider or purchase any health care goods or services from any source. Additionally, no payment under this Agreement is in return for the referral of patients, if any, or in return for purchasing, leasing or ordering services from a party hereto, or any of the parties' affiliates. The parties may refer patients to any company or person providing Services and will make such referrals, if any, consistent with professional medical judgement and the needs and wishes of the relevant parties. Each party will promptly notify the other party of any investigation alleging a violation of law which may affect this Agreement.
- (b) Both parties will comply with all Applicable Laws; with applicable ethical and professional standards; and with currently accepted and approved methods and practices.

10. Confidentiality

- (a) The parties to this Agreement acknowledge that the engagement under this Agreement necessarily indicates that the parties may be dealing with confidential and proprietary information of the other parties including, but not limited to, financial information as well as student and patient information. As such, except as otherwise required by Applicable Laws, the parties and their agents, servants, and employees will at all times after the date of this Agreement not copy, discuss or disclose to anyone, directly or indirectly, any such confidential information to any unauthorized third party. In this regard, the parties will maintain the confidentiality of the information contained in any student-patient's medical records so as not to disclose such information without the written consent of the individual authorized to release such records in accordance with all Applicable Laws, including but not limited to HIPAA and its implementing regulations.
- (b) Upon expiration or termination of this Agreement for any reason District will promptly surrender and return to Provider all copies of any files, records, books, manuals, instructions,

letters, testing reports, and other material, whether written or recorded by electronic, photographic, mechanical or any other means, other than material which are required to be maintained pursuant to Applicable Laws. District will at all times have access to copies of these records and files for legal purposes, which right will survive the termination or expiration of this Agreement for any reason. The cost of any copied requested by the District will be paid for by the District at Provider's customary rates. District acknowledges that these restrictions are reasonable and necessary to protect the legitimate business interests of Provider and the privacy of its student-patients.

(c) A breach of this <u>Section 10</u> will result in irreparable harm to the non-breaching party for which the non-breaching party cannot be reasonably or adequately compensated. Therefore, the non-breaching party will be entitled to equitable remedies including, without limitation, injunctive relief, to prevent a breach and to secure enforcement thereof, in addition to any other relief or award to which they may be entitled.

11. Change in Applicable Laws

The fees are based in part upon the parties' compliance with all Applicable Laws relevant to the services. If there is a material change in any Applicable Law that would make it commercially unreasonable for Provider to provide the Services at the agreed upon rates, Provider will have the right to increase the rates or fees upon written notice to District; provided, however, that District will have the right to terminate this Agreement within thirty (30) days of such notice if it does not agree to accept such rate changes or fee increases. During this thirty (30) day period, the original rates will continue to apply.

12. Severability

Every provision of this Agreement is intended to be severable. If any provision is held to be invalid or unenforceable by law or by a court of competent jurisdiction; all other provisions will nevertheless continue in full force and effect. In lieu of such invalid or unenforceable provisions, there will be added to this Agreement a legal, valid and enforceable provision as similar in terms to such invalid or unenforceable provision as may be possible.

13. Miscellaneous

The following provisions will apply to this Agreement:

- (a) The paragraph headings contained in this Agreement have been prepared for convenience of reference only and will not control, affect the meaning, or be taken as an interpretation of any provision of this agreement.
- (b) Several copies of this Agreement may be executed by the parties, each of which are deemed an original for all purposes, and all of which together constitute but one and the same instrument.
- (c) In the event any term or condition of this Agreement is breached by either party and thereafter waived by the other party, then such waiver will be limited to the particular breach so waived and is not deemed to waive any other breach either prior or subsequent to the breach so waived.

- (d) If the consent of either party is required for whatever reason under the terms of this Agreement, such consent will not be unreasonably withheld.
- (e) Wherever necessary or appropriate, the masculine gender whenever used will include the feminine, and the feminine will include either masculine; the neuter will include both masculine and feminine; the singular will include the plural and the plural will include the singular.
- (f) Defined terms referenced in the recitals set forth above are incorporated into and made a part of this Agreement.
- (g) The parties acknowledge that they are entering into this Agreement solely for their own benefit and purposes, and not for the benefit of any third party.

14. Failure of Performance

If either party to this agreement fails in the due performance of any of its obligation under the terms of this Agreement, the other party will have the right, at its election, to sue for damages for such breach and to seek such legal and equitable remedies as may be available to it. Nothing contained herein will be construed to restrict or impair the rights of either party to exercise this election. All rights and remedies herein provided or existing at law or in equity are cumulative of each other and may be enforced concurrently therewith or from time to time.

15. Notices

Any notice or other communication which is required to be given under the terms of this Agreement will be in writing and delivered personally, or sent by registered mail, or by certified mail return receipt requested. Any notice which is mailed will be deemed to have been given on the second business day after the day of the mailing (not counting the day mailed), irrespective of the date of receipt. Notices may be signed and given by the attorney for the party sending the notice. A new address may be designated by notice.

16. Construction

All understandings and agreements previously made by and between the parties are merged in this agreement, which alone fully and completely expresses their agreement. This Agreement may not be changed, terminated, nor any of its provisions modified or waived, except in writing signed by all of the parties to this Agreement.

17. Applicable Law; Jurisdiction, Venue

This Agreement will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New York without regard to its principles of conflicts of law or without regard to any custom or rule of law requiring construction against the drafter. The County of Ontario in the State of New York is hereby designated as the exclusive forum for any action or proceeding arising from or in any way

connected to this Agreement, and the parties hereby expressly consent to the personal jurisdiction of the state or federal courts in that forum.

18. Binding Effect

This Agreement is binding upon and will inure to the benefit of the parties, their heirs, distributes, legal representatives, transferees, successors, and assigns.

Exhibit A - School Physician Services

FLH Medical, PC will provide for the delivery of School Physician Services. This includes designation of a New York State Licensed physician to serve as the School Physician responsible for consultation, and the development of medical policies. –e.g. first aid protocols, communicable diseases, blood-borne pathogens, influenza, and administration of epinephrine for anaphylaxis.

The School Physician or appropriately New York State licensed Advanced Care Practitioner (ACP) working under the supervision of the School Physician, will be on-site at the District campus up to four hours per day, one day per week during the school season providing direct medical services to students. This can be reasonably adjusted as necessary if a situation requires more on-site coverage. Example, a large number of athletic physicals are required just prior to the start of an athletic season.

FLH Medical, PC will provide examinations or physicals, including 19A physicals, to faculty and staff during a time as mutually agreed to by FLH Medical, PC and the District. These physicals are included in the fees. District faculty, staff, and drivers would be required to travel to Lifecare Medical office.

NYS DOT physicals will also be provided at the Lifecare Medical office.

On-site coverage will not be provided when school is not in session for holidays, closures, and breaks. The District will make reasonable attempts to notify the provider or designee when no student medical services are required for the day. In which case, the physician or ACP would not report to the campus, but would be available for consultation by phone.

The School Physician will be available for consultative services 24 hours per day. The school Physician will attend meetings as reasonably requested by the District.

FLH Medical, PC or one of its Finger Lakes Health affiliated providers will provide one large forum educational session on topics of the District's choosing. –e.g. concussions, healthy lifestyle choices, or sports injuries, etc.

The School Physician or ACP will be available for medical services for student-athletes at all "home" varsity football games.

Exhibit A – School Physician Services

FLH Medical, PC will provide for the delivery of School Physician Services during the 2019-2020 school year. This includes designation of a New York State Licensed physician to serve as the School Physician responsible for consultation, and the development of medical policies. —e.g. first aid protocols, communicable diseases, blood-borne pathogens, influenza, and administration of epinephrine for anaphylaxis.
