



## **VMS Orientation Trip Preview**

Beginning the school year with orientation trips is a cherished VMS tradition. Each orientation trip focuses on building community and forging new friendships before the start of the academic year. In addition, these trips provide students an opportunity to enjoy and appreciate the natural environment in which we live. Through many team-building and creative challenges these trips set a positive, friendly, and supportive tone for the school year.

**Upper School** students will set off on ten separate camping adventures this year. Older students serve in leadership roles to welcome our younger and newer students into our school community. Students demonstrate inclusivity, caring, and kindness by reaching out to make new friends across grade levels. In the water, students will raft, canoe, duckie, kayak, stand up paddle, and fly fish through spectacular stretches of rivers and lakes in Colorado and Utah. On land, the mountain bikers will travel to the Fruita area where they will explore many single track trails. On foot, the backpacking trips will hike with llamas into the Gore Range mountains in our backyard and the rock climbers will ascend walls in the Camp Hale area with their basecamp at a 10th Mountain Division Hut. Considering the incredible impact of these trips on the student experience, and in order to set a positive tone at the start of the school year, we expect all students to attend orientation experiences. Often, if a student is injured, we can make some accommodations to ensure they can participate in some way. The Upper School orientation trip is a two night and three day trip, August 22-24. Students' first day on campus at VMS will be on Thursday, August 25.

At the **Middle School** level, the 6th grade students will have two days of different orientation trip activities. The class will hike to Booth Falls behind VMS, climb at VMS, and challenge their teamwork skills on a Ropes Course with the Breckenridge Outdoor Education Center. The 7<sup>th</sup> grade class will go on a one night rock climbing and camping trip at Turtle Rock outside Buena Vista. The 8<sup>th</sup> grade overnight will be on the river with Timberline Tours guides. Rafts and duckies will be used to introduce the students to class II and III rapids on the Upper Colorado River. The Middle School will begin on

campus on Monday, August 22 and then their orientation days are Tuesday and Wednesday, August 23-24.

The **Lower School** will end the first week with a full day orientation on Friday, August 26. The day is devoted to team building activities, orientation to a student's new classroom and Homebase teacher, setting clear expectations, and developing the sense of joy and belonging for the school year ahead.
