### ABOUT THE SCHOOL

Metrolina Christian Academy is located in Indian Trail, NC, just 20 minutes from downtown Charlotte. The school is a ministry of First Baptist Church in Indian Trail and was founded in 1992. MCA is an accredited institution providing preschool, elementary, middle and upper school education to families in Union County and the surrounding communities.

### COLLEGE ATTENDANCE

Over 70% of MCA graduates attend a four year university immediately following graduation. Approximately 25% choose to continue their studies at a two year post-secondary college, most with plans to transfer to a four year institution. Less than 5% of students opt to join the military or work force.

### CLASS RANK

The MCA Distinguished Scholar Program is the highest academic honor for graduates and serves in lieu of class rank, valedictorian, and salutatorian honors. The Distinguished Scholar Program is by invitation only and those participate have acquired eligibility by completing all honors courses through -out high school with an A for the final grade; requisite dual enrollment elective courses in 11th grade and both core and elective courses in 12th grade. They are also required to have a full class schedule for 12th grade; and complete the Senior Seminar Project consisting of a research essay and formal presentation. MCA Distinguished Scholar designation will be notated on student transcripts.

### GPA CALCULATION

GPA is based on a 4.0 scale and is determined by averaging regular and weighted courses together. Honors courses and college courses taught by MCA instructors receive one extra quality point. Dual enrollment college courses taken offsite or online are not factored into the high school GPA calculation.

### PANDEMIC RESPONSE 2020-2022

The structured standards-driven curriculum program was completed via seated instruction by 95% of students at MCA. Approximately 5% of high school students chose to complete their studies on a virtual platform. MCA did not offer a pass/fail option for any courses taken.

### PURPOSE

The purpose of Metrolina Christian Academy is to provide Christ-like love, promote a biblical worldview, pursue excellence in education, and partner with our families.

### HONORS COURSES

Students may take honors level courses by earning 95% or higher in the pre-requisite standard course and receiving a teacher recommendation. Standardized test scores may also be used to determine placement. Honors courses are available in the following subjects:

- English: 9 Themes, 10 World, 11 American, 12 British & Advanced College English 111 & 112
- Math: Geometry, Algebra II, Math 2, Math 3, Pre-Calculus & Calculus
- Science: Environmental, Biology, Chemistry, Anatomy & Physiology, College Chemistry 151 & 152
- History: World, American, Civics, Economics & Personal Finance
- Foreign Language: Spanish III

All core courses are full-year courses except dual-enrollment courses, which are semester-based.

### COLLEGE COURSES

Metrolina Christian Academy partners with local community colleges and online universities to offer dual and concurrent enrollment classes. Dual enrollment courses taught on campus for 2022-2023 include: BUS 137, ENG 111, ENG 112, CHM 151, 152, MAT 171. Concurrent Enrollment courses include seated and online classes taken for student academic enrichment for college credit.

*Effective 2021-2022: elective courses through concurrent enrollment are not granted credit to count towards MCA graduation.*

Metrolina Christian Academy does not offer Advanced Placement (AP) courses.
