Free Vision Screening and Services - Opt Out Form

Clairton City School District is excited to continue our partnership with ***Vision To Learn***, which provides free vision services to students. ***Vision To Learn*** is a non-profit organization working in communities across the country offering vision services to students in support of their academic achievement. As a result, your child may be eligible to receive ***free*** eyeglasses.

Vision screenings will take place at school and be performed by the school nurse or a trained Vision To Learn staff member. If your child does not pass the screening, she/he will be referred to the ***Vision To Learn*** mobile clinic to receive a basic eye exam by a trained, licensed, and independent optometrist and prescription glasses (if needed). The independent optometrist may also identify and refer students in need of follow-up vision care. Eye exams do not involve eye drops or dilation.

Clairton City School District will share your child's information and vision screening results with ***Vision To Learn***. The optometrist will share your child's eye exam information with ***Vision To Learn*** and the District.

If your child receives a prescription for glasses:

- She/he will choose a frame
- Vision To Learn will order the glasses
- Glasses will arrive at the school within 2-3 weeks
- Glasses will be fitted by a trained and licensed optician
