

Blair Academy Debit Card Supplemental Category Information 2022-23

To help parents better determine how much to fund their child's Debit Card and whether to restrict their child's spending, below is a description of each of the categories and the types of expenditures a student might make in each area.

1. Allowance

Allowance is a restricted or unrestricted amount of cash that can be withdrawn from the student's account at the Bookstore during normal operating hours. Students may use their allowance in stores in town as well as trips to the mall or to the movies. Restrictions are completely up to the parent, but the most common restriction is \$20 per week.

2. Bookstore

Miss Ellen's Bookstore is located in Hardwick Hall. It is open Monday to Friday 9:00 am - 5:00 pm, and Saturday from 9:00 am - 2:00 pm while school is in session. In addition to textbooks, it also sells school supplies such as notebooks, pens, and highlighters, sundries such as deodorant, shampoo, and laundry detergent, and Blair Academy clothing such as sweatshirts, T-shirts, shorts, jackets, and sportswear.

3. Campus Center

The Campus Center (also known as The Black Canteen) is located in Hardwick Hall. It is open Monday to Friday (8:45 am – 11:30 am, 1:00 pm – 5:30 pm, 7:00 pm – 10:30 pm) and Saturday (8:00 am – 11:00 am, 1:00 – 11:30 pm). It hosts a wide variety of food such as bagels, donuts, french fries, pizza, nachos and the ever-popular mozzarella sticks. There are also assorted drinks such as coffee, hot chocolate, cappuccino, milk shakes, juice and soda.

4. Student Activities

Student Activities is a broad category that includes an array of extra-curricular expenditures including club and charity fundraisers (i.e. T-shirts \$15, candy \$1), voluntary trips (i.e. Broadway Plays \$85), club membership fees, and etc.
