

## NURSING REQUIREMENTS

### Application, Admittance, and Continued Progression

Application Requirements	Due
A grade $\geq$ C- in the following courses: BIO 101, 211, 212, 230 CHEM 101 HETH 105	End of the spring semester nursing application is submitted. Verified through transcript in May after final grades are posted.
Cumulative GPA $\geq$ 3.00 Only Wingate University courses are calculated in the GPA.	End of the spring semester nursing application is submitted. Verified through transcript in May after final grades are posted.
Science GPA $\geq$ 2.3 This GPA calculation does include grades from science courses transferred into Wingate University.	End of the spring semester nursing application is submitted. Verified through transcript in May after final grades are posted.
Successful completion/transferred the following courses: BIO 101, 211, 212, 230 CHEM 101 HETH 105, 210 MATH 116, 209 ENG 110 PSYC 101, 250 *Refer to the university catalog course plan for a complete list of all course requirements	End of the spring semester nursing application is submitted. Verified through transcript in May after final grades are posted.
HETH 210 $\geq$ B Students may only repeat HETH 210 ONE time. A second grade $\leq$ B renders the student ineligible to apply to the nursing program.	Verified through transcript in May after final grades are posted.
TEAS Score $\geq$ 72 May be taken multiple times, at Wingate University. Two (2) TEAS will be offered during the spring semester and one (1) TEAS will be offered during the fall semester for any level student. Only TEAS scores taken at Wingate University will be accepted.	One (1) score submitted with Nursing application by May 1.
Submit a completed nursing application available between April 1 – May 1. Applications submitted to Janie McCallister. <i>Applications submitted after May 1 will NOT be accepted.</i> Applications are distributed by HETH 210 faculty. Contact <a href="mailto:j.mccallister@wingate.edu">j.mccallister@wingate.edu</a> to receive an application if not currently enrolled in HETH210.	Due between April 1 to May 1
Program licensed for $59 + 10 = 69$ students = 2 cohorts Applications are put in order of TEAS score to fill available program spots. GPA is considered if there is a TEAS tie. The lowest TEAS accepted for 2021-2023 cohort = 72

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Program Requirements After Admittance	Due
<p><i>CNA-1 course</i> Proof of completion of CNA-1 course in NC or state of student's residence within two (2) years of entering the nursing program or actively on the registry when starting nursing classes after completing CNA-1 course and passing the exam with no 2-year time limit. Students are not required to stay on the registry once enrolled in nursing but students actively on the registry who successfully complete NURS310 can apply for CNA-2 (Nurse Aide II) and be eligible for internships.</p>	At start of program - August
<p><i>American Heart Association Healthcare Provider Basic Life Support (BLS) certification for Healthcare Professionals.</i> American Red Cross is <b>not</b> accepted May take any time as long as hold current certification</p>	At start of program – August  Must renew if expires while enrolled in the nursing program
<p><i>Computer</i> Requirements are sent to newly enrolled students after acceptance into the program</p>	At start of program - August
<p><i>Health Clearance and Immunizations</i> Details will be distributed after acceptance into the program</p>	At start of program - August
<p><i>Uniform and Equipment</i> Details will be distributed after acceptance into the program</p>	At start of program - August
<p><i>ATI</i> A program that provides an all-inclusive package for student success, both in the program and passing NCLEX-RN. The program consists of tutorials, case studies, individual and group exercises; and subject assessments with remediation. NCLEX-RN review occurs during the last semester of the program.</p>	Purchased each semester while enrolled in Nursing; Effective Fall 2022 this cost is part of your nursing program fee, charged with your tuition.
<p><b><i>Program requirements will be sent to all newly accepted students with requirement details and due dates to complete before starting nursing courses in the fall.</i></b></p>	

### Continued Progression Through the Program

All nursing courses final grade of "C" (80) or higher

Clinical courses require *satisfactory* on clinical evaluation

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#### Re-Entry into Program

Students unsuccessful in meeting the progression requirements *during the first semester* can re-apply to the program with the current application pool by submitting an application due May 1.

Students unsuccessful in meeting the progression requirements *after completing the first semester* can request to re-enter the program by successfully passing a content competency examination based on the content of courses already successfully passed and passing a skills competency exam.

***Re-applying and re-entry students are not guaranteed acceptance and they must meet all application and/or re-entry requirements.***
