PARTNER COLLEGES & THEIR PREFERRED REQUIREMENTS

Stark State: Take ACT or Stark State's Accuplacer (certain scores needed for individual classes)

Kent State—Main: 3.0 cumulative GPA, 21 ACT (1 of the following: Eng 18, Math 22, Reading 22)

Kent State—Stark: Take ACT (certain subject scores needed for individual classes)

University of Akron: 3.0 cumulative GPA, 21 ACT (1 of the following: Eng 18, Math 22, Reading 22)

THINGS TO CONSIDER PRIOR TO APPLYING

1. Determine what college(s) you need to apply based on the college(s) that offers the class(es) you want to take (**you may have to apply to multiple colleges**).
2. Do you meet the preferred requirements for the college you are considering (see above)
3. Are you an independent learner?
4. Are you organized and have good time management?
5. Do you take initiative and ownership? (This means the **student** will keep track of applications, usernames, passwords, paperwork, etc. for each college).
6. Students need parental support through the process, **HOWEVER**, the student **MUST** be involved in every aspect to ensure the student understands the process and resources.
7. Parents will **NOT** be able to monitor any CCP class via Progress Book.
8. College and GHS breaks and holidays are rarely the same. You are responsible for following both calendars.

SAMPLE OF HOW CCP CLASSES CAN REPLACE YOUR GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The table below is a list of CCP classes at GHS that can be used for GHS graduation requirements. Classes taken on university campuses have the possibility of meeting graduation requirements. Student must meet with GHS counselor to ensure that it meets the curriculum requirement for graduation.

30 CREDIT HOURS MAXIMUM PER SCHOOL YEAR

A total of 30 credit hours may be successfully completed per school year at no cost. The 30 credit hour total can include **ONE** of the following:

- All college courses OR
- A combination of college and high school courses.
