

Watertown, New York

Watertown is a small city in Northern New York with a population of over 24,000. It is the largest population center in Jefferson County and the county seat. Watertown is located 1/2 hour from the Canadian border, 1 hour from Syracuse, 15 minutes from Fort Drum and with easy access to the Thousand Islands and the Adirondack Park. Watertown International Airport serves the region with flights to Philadelphia, PA.

Settled early in the 19th century, the city's history is reflected in buildings such as the Flower Memorial Library and the Paddock Mansion, which houses the Jefferson County Historical Society. The Thompson Park Zoo is located in an historic park designed by the Olmsted firm.

Today, the region is home to the 10th Mountain Division at nearby Fort Drum, Jefferson Community College, and Samaritan Medical Center. Small manufacturing businesses such as Car-Freshner ("Little Trees") and Knowlton Specialty Papers also provide employment. Local and regional performing art groups offer regular opportunities to experience live music and theater. Outdoor recreation of all kinds is available, with a municipal ice arena at the city fairgrounds and the Dry Hill Ski Area just outside the city limits, and whitewater rafting on the Black River.

District Profile

The Watertown City School District is one of the largest in Jefferson County and has a long history and rich tradition within the community. Featuring a diverse student population and dedicated staff, it has educated generations of residents. The district has five elementary schools, all nestled within residential neighborhoods on both the north and south sides of the city. Its intermediate school, middle school, and high school neighbor each other on a centralized campus. WCSD is one of 18 districts served by Jefferson-Lewis-Hamilton-Herkimer-Oneida BOCES.

Along with providing a comprehensive K-12 education for its approximately 4,000 students, the district offers Advanced Placement programs and dual enrollment courses through our partnership with Jefferson Community College, also located within the city. Students are given a variety of opportunities to excel and earn college credits prior to graduation.

Many higher education opportunities are available locally at Jefferson Community College, St. Lawrence University, Clarkson University, Syracuse University, SUNY Canton, SUNY Potsdam and SUNY Oswego.

The salary of the next Superintendent will be commensurate with experience, with a \$190,000 minimum salary. A full selection of negotiated benefits will be offered to the successful candidate.


The successful candidate will understand the unique character of the school community and be willing to become an active, visible member of the community along with being personally involved in the total educational program.
