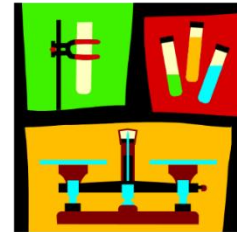
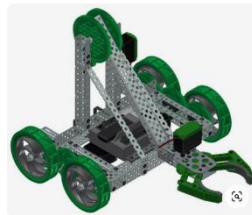
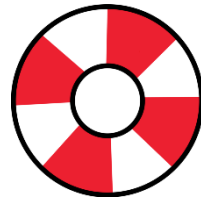

Utah Athletics/Activities Eligibility Requirements:

- Minimum 2.0 GPA in preceding term
- No more than 1 F in preceding term
- No more than 1 U or N in preceding term. Students receiving one “U” or “N” in the preceding grading period will be subject to review by the School Standards Committee.
