

DIPLOMA PATHWAYS

EAB offers three different diplomas for students, each providing rigorous offerings. They are as follows: American Diploma, International Baccalaureate Diploma and Brazilian Diploma. All Brazilian students are required to fulfil both the Brazilian and American graduation requirements.

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE

All EAB students enroll in the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Program and are expected to meet the demands of at least four IB standard-level (SL) courses in order to successfully complete our grade 11-12 program.

Students are encouraged to attempt the full diploma. EAB offers a total of 17 IB subjects at higher and/or standard level across all six subject areas.

GRADING SYSTEM

EAB provides a rigorous college-preparatory program.

At EAB, academic grades for individual classes are based solely on what a student has demonstrated that they have learned, know, and are able to do. Although participation in class and the consistent and careful completion of homework and formative assessments are strong indicators of academic success, the academic grade for students is based solely on their demonstrated mastery of standards on summative assessments. At EAB, students' academic grades are not affected by disciplinary or attendance issues. Extra credit is not awarded in any form.

EAB uses a seven-point scale for both assessing and reporting. The scale fits with EAB's profile as an IB school and is inspired by the IB grade descriptors. It is important to note, however, that the EAB 1-7 grades are informed by, but are not equivalent to, IB scores. Final grades for courses are not merely based on an average of scores on summative assessments, but by the level of mastery a student consistently has shown on a set of standards during his or her time in the course. EAB does not rank students and only calculates GPA when requested for specific college applications.

Please refer to the scale above as a guide to help understand the transition from the 100-point scale to EAB's 7-point scale.

TESTING

EAB is a testing center for the Admissions Testing Program of the College Entrance Examination Board and the American College of Testing Program, and provides testing for the SAT. Grades 2-10 take the Northwest Evaluation Association Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) test three times per year.
