ALVERNIA UNIVERSITY, PA: General academic minimum to meet the guarantee- 3.0 cumulative gpa in academic core classes 1000 SAT Total (EBRW, Math) or 19 ACT Composite. \$15,000 / yr plus \$1,000 Catholic School award at this level.

CARLOW UNIVERSITY, PA: General academic minimum to meet the guarantee- 3.0 cumulative gpa in academic core classes 1060 SAT Total (EBRW, Math) or 21 ACT Composite. \$17,000 / yr plus \$5,000 / yr Catholic School award at this level

IMMACULATA UNIVERSITY, PA: General academic minimum to meet the guarantee- 2.5 cumulative gpa in academic core classes 990 SAT Total (EBRW, Math) or 19 ACT Composite. \$9,000 / yr plus \$2,000 / yr Catholic School award at this level.

MOUNT St. MARY'S UNIVERSITY, MD: General academic minimum to meet the guarantee- 3.0 cumulative gpa in academic core classes 1080 SAT Total (EBRW, Math)* or 21 ACT Composite*. \$22,000 / yr at this level. **Explore and learn at:** msmary.edu

NEUMANN UNIVERSITY, PA: General academic minimum to meet the guarantee- 2.5 cumulative gpa in academic core classes 900 SAT Total (EBRW, Math). \$7,000 / yr at this level. *Explore and learn at:* neumann.edu



ROSEMONT COLLEGE, PA: General academic minimum to meet the guarantee- 3.0 cumulative gpa in academic core classes 1000 SAT Total (EBRW, Math) or 19 ACT Composite. \$4,000 / yr minimum. (\$16,000 total over 4 years) at this level. Current total cost for Rosemont (tuition, room, board, fees) is \$33,915 before merit and other financial aid awarded. *Explore and learn at:* rosemont.edu



WIDENER UNIVERSITY, PA: General academic minimum to meet the guarantee- 3.25 cumulative gpa in academic core classes 1050 SAT Total (EBRW, Math) or 20 ACT Composite. \$25,000 / yr (\$100,000 total over 4 years) at this level. *Explore and learn at:* neumann.edu

STONEHILL COLLEGE, MA: General admission to Stonehill generally requires a B or better cumulative average in academic core, college preparatory classes SAT Total (EBRW, Math) varies as Stonehill is Test Optional.
