ALCOHOL/DRUG USE BY EXTRACURRICULAR PARTICIPANTS POLICY

POLICY STATEMENT

Any student possessing or using drugs or alcohol at school events/activities in which he/she is representing Pikeville High School as a participant or is attending as a part of the team, club, or student group that is participating (This would include students on school sponsored trips where students are being transported and are in the care of the school), will be subject to the following consequences.

This policy covers the entire time a student is enrolled as a student at Pikeville Jr/Sr High School (7-12). For example, if a student is caught in violation of this policy in the 8th grade (first offense), then violates the policy again at grade 11, that would constitute a second offense.

First offense: School punishment as outlined in the student handbook (long term suspension), disciplinary action (approved by administration) from the coach or sponsor of the group in which the student is a member, and counseling.

Second offense: School punishment as outlined in the student handbook (10 day suspension and initiate expulsion procedures) and suspension from further participation in any and all extracurricular (all school related activities not required by a class for a grade including but not limited to clubs, class trips, competitions, etc.) activities for the period of one year from the date of the incident. This includes, but is not limited to athletic participation, club meetings, class trips/outings (extracurricular activities not required for a grade).
