EXTRA-CURRICULAR PARTICIPATION DURING SUSPENSION POLICY

POLICY STATEMENT

Students who have been suspended from school whose suspension period is interrupted by an extended break (any break that lasts for 2 or more school days) may be eligible for participation in extra-curricular activities on all days of the extended break except for the first weekend following the suspension. For example, a student that has been suspended for 5 days starts the suspension on Thursday. The student is out of school on both Thursday and Friday. Christmas vacation begins on Friday afternoon and is scheduled to last two full weeks. The student would be ineligible for participation Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday of the week the suspension began. The student would finish the suspension on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday of the week that student returns to school after Christmas vacation. The student would be allowed to participate in extra curricular activities all other days of the Christmas break.

*As per board policy, students who are suspended are not to participate in extra-curricular activities on snow days that occur during their suspension period.
