- 1) Home school credits will be accepted under the following circumstances:
  - a) An accurate record of pupil attendance must be submitted to school personnel, verifying that the student has received 175 days of instruction per year of home school.
  - b) The courses must be comparable in content to those offered at PHS. A course outline for each class must be submitted to school personnel to make that determination.
  - c) Samples of student's work from each class (i.e. tests, writing samples, papers) must be submitted.
- 2) No credits from home school will be accepted beyond the 9<sup>th</sup> grade year. A maximum of 7 credits earned in home school will be accepted: a maximum of 3 ½ per semester or a total of 7 for the 9<sup>th</sup> grade year.
- 3) The school reserves the right to withdraw a student from a class if he/she does not have the background needed to successfully complete that class. Thus, a student may have to repeat a course, or courses, for which he/she has already received credit before proceeding to a higher-level course.
- 4) Home school grades will be recorded as either P for pass or F for fail, and will not figure into the student's grade point average at PHS.
