Do I need an A.S. in Photography to enroll in the UCF B.S. in Photography?

Yes. The UCF B.S. in Photography degree program is a 2+2 articulated partnership with Daytona State College. UCF teaches the third and fourth year courses. If you have an A.S. in Photography from an institution other than DSC you can still enroll in the upper division UCF program. Contact the program coordinator and provide your A.S. degree transcripts for degree verification.

Can I study photography in an area of my choice?

Yes. While our courses do have specific directions, assignments, and goals, within most of the shooting classes are opportunities for you to create work that is directed towards your specific career goals.

Are the classes all offered on the Daytona campus?

All of the photography and general education program courses in the B.S. in Photography degree program are offered on the Daytona Beach campus with one exception and that course is provided online.

Does UCF have photography equipment available for students to check out?

Yes. There are a variety of camera lenses, lights, studio accessories, and equipment associated with still and video production available in the stockroom for the UCF students at no charge. DSC also has an extensive stock of equipment available for student use. Some of the DSC equipment is free of charge while a portion of it is rented/checked-out to students for a nominal fee.
