### 8690 MONITORING DEVICES IN SCHOOLS, ON SCHOOL PROPERTY AND SCHOOL VEHICLES

The Board of Education recognizes that safe and secure conditions for all pupils is paramount. Pupils must maintain proper discipline at all times in school, on school grounds, and on school owned or contracted school vehicles.

To maintain the safe and secure conditions for all pupils, the Board may use devices to monitor and/or observe student behavior, teacher and support staff behavior, school bus driver discipline procedures and/or school bus driver driving techniques. The device may be a sound video camera, a voice monitoring device, or other appropriate devices. Each school will have a sign clearly posted stating that:

"Video And/Or Audio Monitoring Devices Are Used In This School Or On School Owned And Contracted Vehicles"

The recording may be used in pupil and staff discipline matters, driver evaluations, or for discipline or training. Notice of this policy will be provided to parents/legal guardians and all personnel each year in staff, pupil and/or parent handbooks.
