- A. **Agenda Item:** Superintendent's Report

Presenter: Dr. Dana Ayers, Superintendent

Dr. Ayers reported on the following:

1. The final days of school went well and we are already planning for the fall. During the summer we remain extremely busy with summer programs, CTE camps, NASA camp and a plethora of meetings as we prepare to welcome students and staff in the fall.
2. As we plan for the upcoming year, we have much to celebrate! We have made good progress in many academic areas and are looking at tremendous growth in our preschool programs. I am excited that we are opening four new preschool classrooms along with the three we currently have. This means we will be serving nearly 125 preschoolers across Jackson County in seven classrooms!
3. I'd also like to share with our community the continued need for bus drivers, school nutrition workers and custodians. These are just a few of the much-needed positions that are available for the upcoming year. Starting pay for most of these positions is \$15/hour while bus drivers will begin at \$15.50/hour. I implore you to browse our jcpsnc.org website and apply or contact HR Director Teri Walawender at 828-586-2311 for more information. It is imperative we fill bus driving positions prior to school starting on August 22nd.
4. During the summer months our principals are organizing, cleaning, scheduling and recruiting. I am so grateful for very strong leadership teams in JCPS. From the school campuses to the central office, and our board members, we have amazing leaders.
5. This evening I would like to recognize two Board of Education members who have been strong leaders for many, many years. Mrs. Laird-Large has served on the Jackson County Board of Education since 1998. She was elected board chair for a second two-year term beginning July 2020. Prior to becoming a board member, Mrs. Large was a leader in the parent volunteer program of Jackson County Public Schools, serving on various committees. She has also worked with Social Services, Harris Regional Hospital and many local foundation boards as well as serving community churches by planning events and directing church programs. Her philosophy is that she, other board members, and everybody involved in teaching children, should help prepare them for the path, not make the path for them. In the time I have worked with Ali, I have learned that she has a passion for our community and a commitment to better ALL students in our district. She is involved in a multitude of activities that will continue to support Jackson County. Mrs. Large is kind, big-hearted and focused on helping anyone in her path. She will be greatly missed! Dr. Ayers asked Mrs. Laird-Large to come forward and presented her with a plaque as a token of appreciation for her many years of dedication to JCPS.
6. Mrs. McRae is a retired educator, having been in education for more than 25 years. She spent the last nine years of her career with Jackson County Public Schools teaching at Blue Ridge. Mrs. McRae and her husband have successfully raised and educated four children. She has continued to work with children since her retirement, through church and community activities. Mrs. McRae was appointed to fill the unexpired term of Nathan Moss and was re-elected in 2018. She has a fierce love for the Cashiers community and a desire for students to receive a top-notch education while expecting students to soar and thrive. She is witty, sometimes feisty and dedicated to student progress and growth. She, too, will be missed in JCPS! Dr. Ayers asked Mrs. McRae to come forward and presented her with a plaque as a symbol of gratitude for her service as a BOE member.

All activities/items will be free of charge and will include: bookbags, school supplies, sports physicals, haircuts, clothing, immunizations and school information.
