A RESOLUTION to authorize the superintendent to sign the interlocal Agreement with the City of SeaTac, allowing shared use of the Tye Educational Complex parking area and Vally Ridge Park facilities and parking area; and

WHEREAS, the City of SeaTac constructed a 12-court indoor tennis facility at Valley Ridge Park, located adjacent to the Highline School District's Tye Educational Complex; and

WHEREAS, the district will allow the City use of the Tye Educational Complex parking area for Park users during non-school hours; and





WHEREAS, the City will allow the Tye High School's sports teams and physical education program use of the Valley Ridge Park tennis courts, certain Parks facilities, and parking area during school hours; and

WHEREAS, additionally, the Tye Educational Complex will be allowed the use of the Park's facilities on evenings and weekends with the approval of a Facility Use Agreement with the City of SeaTac Parks and Recreation Department.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of Highline School District No. 401, King County, Washington, that the Highline School District No. 401 enter into a ten-year Interlocal Agreement between Highline School District No. 401 and the City of SeaTac regarding shared facility use at Valley Ridge Park and the Tye Educational Complex parking area, and hereby authorize the superintendent to sign and deliver any and all necessary documents to carry out the actions authorized by this resolution.
