

Medication Administered on Campus

Students may not keep medication (prescription or over-the-counter) in their possession on campus. All medication must be given to the front office to administer according to the written instructions provided by the parent/guardian. The form that follows should be used to indicate dosage and schedule. Complete as many forms as needed.

Medication that is for occasional or emergency use may also be left in the office with instructions. (Examples: Tylenol, cough drops, special ointments or creams, etc.)

Inhalers and EpiPens are kept in the office but please discuss this with the office staff and the teachers to ensure that supplies are available to best suit the needs of your child's level of reaction.

Please clearly label all medication with the child's name and submit in a ziplock bag. Medication can be brought to the office prior to the start of the school year or any school day as the year progresses.
