

Farmington Junior High Student Handbook Quick Reference Sheet

***The following is a quick summary of policy and procedure found in the FJH Student Handbook, to see the full policy access the student handbook on the FJH website.

Attendance:

- FJH is a closed campus, students must check out in the office before leaving or they may be issued a truancy and/or given an administrative “U.”
- Parent/guardians must show ID to check out their student.
- Parent/guardians may excuse a student’s absence on myDSD or by reaching out to the school at 801-402-6900 or farmingtonjrattendance@dsdmail.net.
- Students that are late to class will be marked tardy, four tardies in one class will result in loss of citizenship credit.

Counseling Center

- Counselors are responsible for all schedule changes. Schedule changes may be made only on schedule change days. We will not add students to classes that are already full.

Discipline:

- Students are expected to follow school rules, when they do not, they may be issued discipline points by the administration. Students with more than 50 discipline points will face increased consequences and may be excluded from end-of-year activities.

Electronic Devices:

- Students are expected to know their teachers’ policies on electronic devices.
- If devices are used inappropriately they may be sent to the office where discipline points, parent phone calls, or other corrective measures may be taken.
- Electronic devices should be used to help the learning process, they should never be used to bully or harass others, or to access inappropriate material. Please be familiar with and follow the Davis District Acceptable Use policy.

Dress Code: The dress code exists to help create a positive and professional learning environment. (Please view the full dress code in the FJH Student Handbook)

- Shoes must be worn.
- Shorts and skirts must be longer than half the length of the student’s thigh, even when sitting.
- Shirts shall cover the student’s entire upper torso. Bare midriffs and sheer fabrics are not allowed.
- No inappropriate images or suggestive wording is allowed on clothes, this includes images that represent or include drugs, alcohol, or tobacco.
- Baseball caps and beanies are allowed at FJH, but hats may not cause a disruption to the learning environment.

Bus and Bus Conduct

- Students may only ride the bus to which they are assigned through the district transportation office.
- Students that do not follow bus rules will be subject to school discipline and may lose their bus-riding privileges.
