Homeroom Assignments

All students will receive a letter from his/her homeroom teacher between August 4 and August 6. Please contact Anna McCubrey (amccubrey@portergaud.edu) if your child has not received a letter by August 8.

Orientation for Parents of New Students | Wednesday, August 10, 5:30pm-6:15pm

• At this event, parents will have the opportunity to learn about Lower School processes and procedures, ask questions, and meet important staff members.

First Day of School | Tuesday, August 16

- This is a full day of school for all Lower School students.
- All Lower School students should wear a regular uniform (no PE uniforms).
- We invite parents to park in the paved Lower School lot (or other designated area; **not in the Lower School carpool loop or on Albemarle Road**) and walk children into their classrooms between 7:30 and 8:00 (this is not mandatory as some children may arrive to school by bus or with older siblings).
- Parents will receive their official carpool sign from their homeroom teacher during this drop-off time (for parents who do not come into classrooms, signs will be sent home with child).
- Dismissal will be at 2:55pm from the Lower School carpool loop. We will run a regular dismissal from the carpool loop.
- We will have morning and afternoon bus service and Extended Day

Lower School Parents Night is Wednesday, August 24, 6:00pm-7:30pm

 Parents will meet their child's teachers, spend time in classrooms, and learn more about curriculum and programming.

Carpool

Morning Drop-off – All students should be dropped off in the Lower School carpool loop. Drop off is from 7:30am to 7:50am on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. Homeroom begins at 7:50am. Students arriving after 7:50am are considered tardy and must sign in with the receptionist in the Lower School office. For the safety of students, we ask that students not be dropped off prior to 7:30am.

- We encourage all students to arrive on campus between 7:30am and 7:45am to allow enough time to unpack and prepare for their day.
- Please note, times are one hour later on Wednesday mornings due to our late-in
 Wednesday schedule (drop off between 8:30am and 8:50am). Please contact us if this late start on Wednesdays poses an undue burden for your family.

Afternoon Dismissal

- Lower School Carpool Pick-Up | 2:55pm-3:15pm
 - Lower School dismissal begins at 2:55pm.
 - Students who ride the bus, attend Enrichment activities, and/or Extended Day will be dismissed at the appropriate times.
- Middle School Carpool Pick-Up with Lower School Siblings | 3:15pm-3:30pm
 - If you have a student in the Middle School, you can pick up both your Lower School child(ren) and Middle School child(ren) in the Lower School carpool loop between 3:15pm and 3:30pm.
 - If you are picking up your Middle and Lower School children together, please do not arrive in the Lower School loop until 3:15pm.
- All Lower School children who have not been picked up by 3:30pm will go to Extended Day.
- All after-school pick up information for Lower School students must be entered into SchoolPass (SchoolPass is a new system which is replacing School Dismissal Manager used in the past; information will be shared on how to use this app prior to the start of school).

Lunch

We welcome parents to join their children for lunch throughout the school year.

We request that **parents do not come for lunch until September 12** to allow our children time to acclimate to lunchroom procedures.

• Please note: When coming to campus for lunch, parents need to check in at the Lower School office and pay the \$5 fee.
