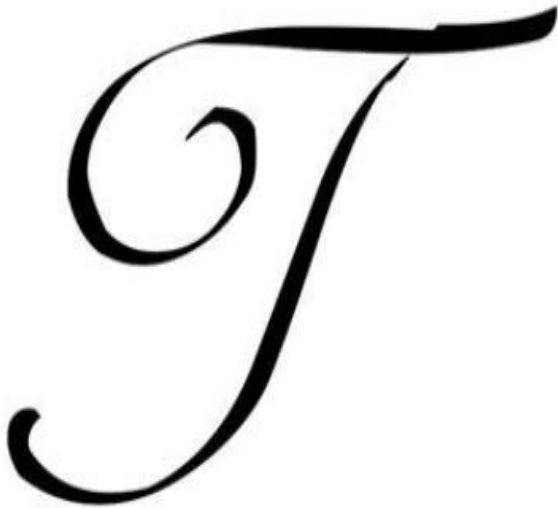
Patty:

The

Tracy Fund was established and shared between the elementary and high schools. In 1960 when new schools were built, the Tracy Foundation was created awarding scholarships to the Valedictorians and Salutatorians. Peter Tracy, the grandson of Mr. Tracy has continued the legacy of his Grandfather helping countless students continue their education.
