Transportation will be provided. For students who need devices for virtual instruction, distributions will be held at the Fell Center (650 North Saginaw) on August 26th, 30th and 31st from 8 a.m.-5 p.m.

Although these inconveniences can be disheartening at the start of the school year, we know they are only temporary. We look forward to welcoming everyone into their permanent homes in the coming months.
