Confirmed Positive Test for COVID 19 STAY HOME

STAFF

Enter absences & notify your supervisor of your absences

STUDENT

Notify Office/Attendance clerks of absences & provide medical documentation to excuse absences with the OR code



STAFF AND STUDENTS STAY HOME (ISOLATE)

Follow the guidance of your healthcare provider. You may return when:

At least **5 days** have passed since symptoms first appeared

Or from first positive test date (if asymptomatic at test date)

AND

24 hours have passed without fever or use of fever-reducing medication



SCAN ME

Same Household/Direct Exposure

Being directly exposed to someone <u>diagnosed as POSITIVE COVID-19</u> within the same household.



Have you received a booster vaccine?

Have you been fully vaccinated with Pfizer or Moderna (series of 2 shots)?

Have you completed the J&J vaccine?

Have you tested positive for COVID and/or received monoclonal antibodies in the last 90 days?



IF YES, RETURN TO WORK/SCHOOL If you develop symptoms, stay home

IF NO, STAY HOME (QUARANTINE)

You may opt to return when:

- 5 days after last exposure have passed
 AND
- Have not developed any symptoms.

*If symptoms develop, stay home. Recommended to seek testing.
