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Prescription medication may be stored and dispensed to students but not without parent's request and physician's authorization. Prescription medication to be stored and dispensed in the principal's office must be in a prescription labeled container and taken to the school office in a safe manner. All procedures that may be necessary will be in accordance with the standard operating procedures of the local health department.

Parents have the responsibility of maintaining the supply of medication to be dispensed. The only performance to be accomplished by School District personnel is to supply storage space for medication. Medication left with school personnel may be dispensed by school personnel to students whose parents have given written consent. Medication shall be administered by injection by school personnel under life-threatening conditions only as per Board policy.
