



Dear Parents of 4th, 5th, and 6th Grade Students,

Your student may apply for permission to ride his/her bicycle to school. However, your student must live within walking distance of Magnolia and not qualify for bus transportation to school.

If your child is a “walker” and is interested in riding a bicycle to school please review the bicycle safety rules. Please sign and return this permit to the school office.

BICYCLE SAFETY RULES

1. Bike riders **MUST** wear a helmet, when riding a bike.
2. Always ride your bike on the right hand side of the road. Bikes travel in the same direction as cars.
3. Obey all the traffic rules:
 - Stop at STOP signs
 - Only one person on a bike
 - Always use hand signals
4. Walk your bicycle on school grounds and use designated crosswalks with crossing guard supervision.
5. Walk your bike across the street.
6. Always ride in single file. **Ride behind your friends, not next to them.**
7. Cutting in and out of traffic is dangerous and not permitted.
8. Lock your bicycle in a rack and stay away from other students' bicycles.
9. Ride your bicycle safely when off school grounds following all rules of the road.
10. Do not allow another person to ride your bicycle.
11. Have a school permit slip, signed by a parent, on file in the school office.
12. Have a license (available from the Upland Police Department).
