Mark T. - Questioning a \$9.00 room charge from the bar while District leaders were at a conference in California.

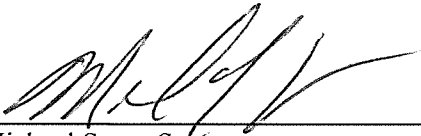
Paula - Give the current Board a chance.
