

Fan Code of Conduct

Sportsmanship is an essential part of any athletic competition and is expected from athletes, coaches, officials, and fans. As a fan/spectator (student or adult) of Liberty High School, we want you to be an example of positive encouragement while supporting our athletes, coaches, and officials. Our behavior will reflect our core values of honesty, integrity, respect, and personal responsibility. Fans and spectators should be positive, respectful, and encouraging of all participants in the competition.

LHS Athletics Requires:

- Enthusiastic support of your team – Positive comments made only!
- Good sportsmanship – Let the officials “officiate”
- Family friendly atmosphere – appropriate language
- Commitment to safety of all
- Welcoming attitude to all fans and visitors

Unacceptable Behaviors:

- Disruptive or unruly behavior
- Negative comments or negative cheers directed at opposing players
- Foul or abusive language or obscene gestures
- Rudeness to fellow fans or Liberty High School staff
- Use of alcohol, vape products, tobacco, or other drugs
- Interference with the progress of the game, including throwing objects onto the field, or running on the playing surface
- Signage that is offensive, in poor taste, or does not support sportsmanship
- Failing to follow instructions of sporting event personnel
- Any other violations of the CCPS student code of conduct

Fans who display unacceptable behaviors will be subject to sanctions up to and including refusal of admittance, removal, and possible long-term ejection. Other violations of the CCPS student code of conduct will be subject to behavioral consequences outlined by CCPS policy.
