- D. Regional standardized test facilitation which directly supports the BUUSD's educational mission. Examples include: SAT's, ASVAB's, ACT's

#### Group 3 (BUUSD policy E20) -

- A. Non-BUUSD schools for educational, co- and extra curricular or school sponsored activity
- B. Non-profit organizations other than those qualified for Group 2

### Group 4 (BUUSD policy E20) -

A. All other individuals, groups, or agencies

#### Notes:

- Renters are required to carry insurance and are responsible for all costs associated with any repairs resulting from their use of facilities.
- All indoor events require BUUSD staff presence; the number of staff is determined by the school with consideration to the size, location, and if non-participating students are present during the event.
