Instructional Leadership Team

The team talked about some of the aspects of the social-emotional training that the Educational Service Center provided us last week. We will be incorporating some of our learning into the professional development day in October for all staff.

Teacher Academy

Jessie Zink is leading our new Pre-Apprenticeship Teacher Academy program at the High School this year. We currently have 13 students in the program. All of these students are high school seniors who are interested in pursuing a career in education. They are learning about various topics related to the field of education and going out into classrooms in the district to observe and work with teachers in the field.

MTSS Process

Our Multi Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS) process is up and running this year. In this process, students are given benchmark assessments in Reading and Math to determine their needs. Teachers have been reviewing this data and making plans for interventions for students who need additional support. Each building has a plan in place to provide these interventions and time for teachers to review and use the data. Everyone has been working very hard to meet the needs of our students this year.
