

# Gifted Reading at Northmont

## Grades 2–3

Gifted readers are intentionally grouped together in a regular classroom. The classroom teacher provides students with differentiated work.

**Focus Skills:** Advanced independent reading, vocabulary development

## Grades 4–6

Gifted readers are intentionally grouped together in a regular classroom. Once a week, students will see a gifted intervention specialist. They will be assigned work to complete in their ELA classroom in place of regularly assigned work.

**Focus Skills:** Advanced reading, grammar, advanced writing, executive functioning

## Grades 7–8

Gifted readers are enrolled in a gifted reading class that meets daily and is taught by a gifted intervention specialist.

**Focus Skills:** Advancement of state content standards

## Grades 9–12

Gifted readers have the option to take honors, Advanced Placement (AP) and College Credit Plus (CCP) coursework.
